

The six text fields share the same value. Such an array of fields is called a field group. All fields in the group must be of the same type.

A field group can be created in two different ways: either create two or more fields with the same name or pass the handle of the base field as Parent to the children. The latter way is more efficient since it is not required to search for the parent field when a child will be created.

Enter some more text into a field to see the difference between auto size and fixed font size.

Font size ≤ 1.0 means auto size.
